From the desk of Fr. Darrell

There have been many challenges which the churches in this area have faced during the last two years. Additionally, the tragic loss of Pastors and retired clergy has created a feeling of uncertainty about the future. We have also had to face the reality of an aging population, with many of them returning to the Lord.

For years, the Clergy have been spreading themselves thin trying to maintain all the usual mass times for each worship site. Fewer clergy are trying to handle all aspects of parish life while taking on the responsibility of more and more parishes. This unfortunately is not sustainable. We find ourselves faced with some hard decisions.
