

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo, N.Y ("Diocese") files for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The Court entered an Order (the "Supplemental Bar Date Order") setting April 17, 2023 at 11:59 P.M.
