### St. James Parish — Seventh Sunday of Easter

### From the desk of Fr. Paul Cygan

A 15th century Dominican friar named Blessed Alan de la Roche reignited devotion to the Holy Rosary throughout Christendom. According to Dominican tradition and sources it is said that the Blessed Virgin Mary gave Blessed Alan fifteen promises for those who faithfully pray the Rosary. These are the fifteen promises:

- 1. Whosoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary shall receive signal graces. (signal graces = a simple sign in daily life that answers a question made in prayer or points towards God's will)
- 2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
- 3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin and defeat heresies.
- 4. It will cause good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire for Eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means!
- 5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish. (aka Saved from hell)
- 6. Whosoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying themselves to the consideration of its Sacred Mysteries, shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise them in His justice, they shall not perish by an unprovided death; if they be just, they shall remain in the grace of God, and become worthy of Eternal life.
- 7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.
- 8. Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have during their life and at their death the Light of God and the plentitude of His graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of his Saints in paradise.
- 9. I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.
- 10. The faithful children of the Rosary shall merit a high degree of Glory in Heaven.
- 11. You shall obtain all you ask of me by recitation of the
- 12. All those who propagate the Holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.
- 13. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire Celestial Court during their life and at the hour of death.
- 14. All who recite the Rosary are my children and brothers and sisters of my Only Son Jesus Christ.

Devotion to my Rosary is a great sign of predestination. (In other words, a good indication that one is on the path to heaven.)

The Rosary is a powerful prayer and often called a spiritual weapon because of its effectiveness in the spiritual life. St. Therese of Lisieux explains the Rosary in this way, "The rosary is a long chain that links Heaven and earth. One end of it is in our hands and the other end is in the hands of the Holy Virgin... The Rosary prayer rises like incense to the feet of the Almighty." May we renew our dedication and love for this beautiful prayer of the Church!
