St. James Parish — Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the desk of Fr. Faul Cygan

In 2017, Pope Francis declared July 22nd to be the feast day of St. Mary Magdalene. In his papal address commemorating this occasion, he described Mary Magdalene as an apostle, a messenger of the Gospel and beautifully shared how she was the first to be visited by Christ after His resurrection.

St. Mary Magdalene was present at crucial points of Jesus' earthly ministry. She was healed by Christ of the seven demons that possessed her, in the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke) it is possible that it was she who wiped the feet of Jesus with her tears before Jesus entered his Paschal Mystery, she was present at the foot of the Cross with Jesus' mother and the Apostle John, and she the first to rejoice in the resurrection of Christ in the garden outside the tomb.

Needless to say, St. Mary Magdalene is a very important figure in the canon of saints. We praise God that she now has her own feast day so that we can commemorate her discipleship and emulate her love for our Lord.

Traditional Prayer to St. Mary Magdalene:

O Glorious St. Magdalene, "model of penitents," obtain for me the grace of perseverance in the practices of self-denial according to the Spirit of my vows; pray to God for me that I may appear before Jesus Our Lord and Master, at the moment of my death, with my lamp filled with the oil of faith and hope, burning with the pure flame of charity; and thus merit to be received with thee into His eternal Kingdom. Amen.
