St. James Parish — Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the desk of Fr. Paul Cygan

For five days in early August, Pope Francis joined 1.5 million young people from the whole world for World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal. It was a festival of spreading the joy and love of our Catholic faith. It is an opportunity for the exuberance and zeal of the young people of the world to inspire our hearts and to enliven the Church as a whole.

In Pope Francis' multiple appearances, Masses and prayers, he shared with the vast crowd about the importance of being peacemakers in a world rife with conflict. During his Angelus prayer he said, "Dear friends, allow me, as an older person, to share with you, young people, a dream that I carry within me. It is a dream of peace, the dream of young people praying for peace, living in peace and building a peaceful future. As we pray the Angelus, let us place the future of humanity into the hands of Mary, the Queen of Peace." As you can imagine, this message was very relatable to our young people especially in our global world where the lack of peace is readily felt.

But Pope Francis also gave a word of encouragement and hope during the Mass where he and 30 cardinals, 700 bishops and 10,000 priests celebrated the Feast of the Transfiguration. Pope Francis urged the young people, "to be radiant in your youthfulness, to bring the light of the Gospel everywhere, and to be beacons of hope in these dark times... after these exciting days surely we feel like repeating the words of the Apostle Peter on the mount of the Transfiguration: 'Lord, it is good for us to be here!' (Mt. 17:4) In the wake of these grace -filled days, we can also ask an important question, 'What will we take back with us as we come down from the mountain to resume our daily lives?""

He went on to explain the verb "shine" in the Transfiguration account, "His face shines like the sun and his clothes become dazzling white. Through this brilliant burst of light, Jesus prepares the disciples for the dark night they will have to endure; this overwhelming experience of light would help them to endure the dark hours of Gethsemane and Calvary. We, too, need a burst of light if we are to face the darkness of the night, the challenges of life, the fears that plague us, and the gloom that often overtakes us. That light, the Gospel tells us, has a name. Yes, the light that has come to illumine the world is Jesus himself. He is the sun that never sets, but continues to shine even amid the darkness of the night."

In a very personal way Pope Francis then told them, "I would like to look each of you in the eye and say: Do not be afraid! Now I will tell you something even more beautiful: Jesus himself is now looking at you. He knows you; he knows what is in your heart; he smiles at you and tells you once again that he loves you, always and infinitely. Do not be afraid, for the Lord loves you and walks at your side."

It doesn't matter how old or young you are. These encouraging words of Pope Francis remind us of the importance of looking to the light of Christ in times of darkness and to not be afraid because he is near.
