Anointing of the Sick

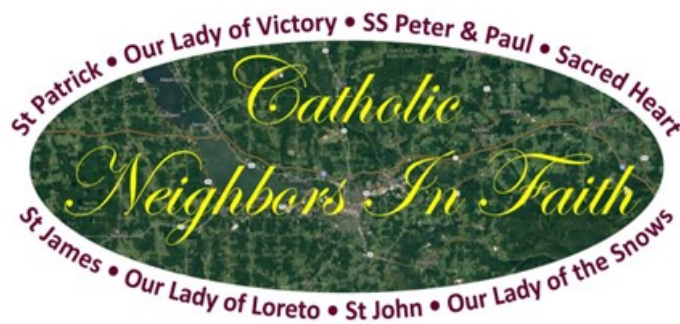
Please call rectory immediately in case of serious illness. The Sacrament is appropriately received by anyone of any age when seriously or chronically ill, following an accident or before surgery.

From the desk of Fr. Paul:

Angels are real! We have so many depictions of them in our daily lives. Remember those cartoons that depicted an angel on one shoulder and the devil on the other? Or sometimes we call those people who have been there for us in a great time of need our angels. When I'm driving I often think about the warning, "Don't drive faster than your angel can fly." Thinking back on our childhood, we probably prayed the Guardian Angel prayer and had the picture of the guardian angel protecting children crossing a rickety bridge. I love these little reminders of the spiritual life. In our liturgical calendar we are coming up on some significant feast days reminding us of the angels, Sept. 29th - the feast day of the Archangels and Oct. 2nd - the feast day of our Guardian Angels. These are opportunities for us to reflect on the gift of the angels, God's messengers, in our lives.

First a Biblical suggestion for you. If you ever want to read something from the Bible that involves healing, marriage and angels, the Book of Tobit is for you. What a trifecta! It is a short compelling story about how God provided for Tobiah and Tobit in their time of need and blessed them through the support of St. Raphael, the archangel.

There are nine choirs of angels that are revealed throughout Scripture.

1) Seraphim 2) Cherubim 3) Thrones 4) Dominations 5) Powers 6) Virtues 7) Principalities 8) Archangels 9) Angels. The first three choirs of angels are always before the presence of God and contemplating the mystery of God. The next three choirs have knowledge of the divine secrets of God and are concerned with governing the universe, watching over God's creation. The last three choirs are the ones we often see within the narratives of Scripture because they are involved with the story of salvation. A few examples: Principalities are the guardians of nations, The story of St. Michael and the triumph over Satan in Revelation, St. Gabriel being God's messenger to Mary in the Annunciation, St. Raphael in his healing ministry in the Book of Tobit, angels ministering to Jesus after His forty days in the desert.

As we come up on these two feasts of the Archangels and our Guardian Angels, let us be mindful of how God has sent us his heavenly messengers to help us on our way to heaven. May our guardian angels lead us to Jesus and away from sin and the archangels bring us God's Word, His healing and His protection!
