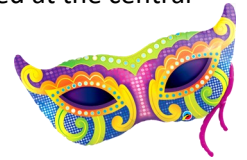
Join the Italian Dancers on Saturday, February 10, 2024 for a fun-filled evening 5-8pm at the St. James Church Hall on 27 Allen Street.

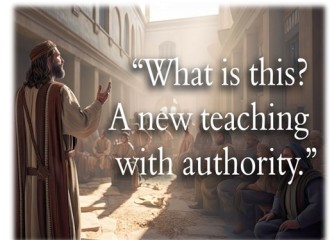
Reflections

Thunderbolts and Lightening

One of the most difficult duties of a disciple is to follow the command of Jesus to spread the gospel to all nations. (Lk 24:47, Mk 116:15, Mt 28:19) I think one reason may be that we don't feel we have the authority to tell someone else what to believe. Most of us don't think we know the gospel well enough to preach it. Or we are so afraid of offending atheists, that we use that fear as an excuse to say nothing. But being a disciple means following Jesus. The gospel this Sunday mentions twice that Jesus taught with more authority than any of religious leaders of Israel. So how can we get such authority?

First, Jesus didn't get his authority from winning a Messiah election. And he didn't threaten people with thunderbolts and lightning. He certainly didn't impress people by saying what they wanted to hear. He spoke the truth that he heard from his Father. His two main actions in his ministry were curing and forgiving people. Since the Jews thought sickness was a punishment for sins, by curing the sick and forgiving sins, Jesus showed that God loves even sinners. And those actions showed that Jesus got authority from his Father.

"But you still haven't answered the question: How do we get that authority?" We get it from the Holy Spirit, in Baptism and Confirmation. And like an athlete, who may be born with strength and abilities, yet has to work-out and practice to be any good, we still need to grow in that authority. One way is to read the scriptures and pray with them, so that we get to know God through his Word and begin to listen to him in our prayers. We can consciously decide to see God in other people, not just those we love, but everyone, even the ones who annoy us. (And especially the ones who challenge us to be more loving, patient and forgiving.) Most parishes have programs that encourage sharing your faith, such as RCIA, Christ Re-news his Parish, etc. And of course, the Eucharist and other sacraments strengthen God's life in us. You'll know you have that authority when you can talk about your faith with confidence instead of hesitation, because you will be speaking from experience, not second hand knowledge.



God's Authority

Today's Gospel states, "The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority." What does "authority" mean? Whether we feel the most helpless, or in total control of everything around us, Christ always has the power to take over. At times he allows suffering. Other times He will cure or even provide miracles. The when and why are a mystery, but what is clear is that such encounters, the sweetest and the most sorrowful, help us to recognize our reliance on His dominion.

In today's world, many often try to survive day to day as if God doesn't exist. We go about our worldly business ignorant and distracted. Sometimes when things get bad we still try to take it into our own hands, afraid to ask for help. Yet we were never created to exist without God. In fact, CS Lewis once wrote, "The worst thing we can do to God is leave him alone." God longs for us. He thirsts for us.

Let us continue to be amazed in today's day and age, just like those who witnessed Christ's miracles firsthand. For His great deeds continue to live on forever. May we always be thankful and eager to respond with similar love for one another.

Saint John Bosco — Feast Day, Jan. 31st

(Aug. 15, 1815—Jan. 31, 1888)

A Reflection: John Bosco educated the whole person—body and soul united. He believed that Christ's love and our faith in that love should pervade everything we do—work, study, play. For John Bosco, being a Christian was a full-time effort, not a once-a-week, Mass-on-Sunday experience. It is searching and finding God and Jesus in everything we do, letting their love lead us. Yet, because John realized the importance of job-training and the self-worth and pride that come with talent and ability, he trained his students in the trade crafts, too.
